Go Live Plan!

The Telkwa Community Church Council and Worship Committee have been planning for how our church family can gather for worship and fellowship. We invite you to be curious in how for God might meet us in this. All this is based on the BC Centre for Disease Control's "Guidelines for Faith-Based Organizations to Prevent the Spread of COVID-19". Our guidelines will be updated as per the recommendations of BCCDC.

1. We request anyone feeling ill to please stay home.
2. Our services will be capped at 50 people, and we will contact each attendee should someone have attended with COVID. When planning to attend, we'll make it easy to sign up beforehand. As we have more than 50 people per service, we'll add a second service.
3. We've organized our worship space to facilitate separate entry and exit points in a way that's both spiritually meaningful and safe. Hand sanitizer will be widely available.
4. We plan to change the meeting space — making it more personal by removing pews — and to facilitate physical distancing for those outside their family bubble.
5. We will live stream the service via zoom for those unable to attend.
6. We intend to provide nursery for families with children under 5 as volunteers are available. Kiddos 5 can craft in pew with family.
7. You'll notice the service to be simpler and shorter than normal. We will include congregational singing.
8. When Communion is celebrated, please take the bread and juice from the table and move back to your seat.
9. There will be a single offering plate in the back of the church, however, everyone will be encouraged to donate electronically.
10. Fellowship will take place outside (after all, we're hardy people).

We believe that we can have deeply meaningful times together while observing public health guidelines. We warmly invite any suggestions or feedback to help make it so!
